A letter has been received from Eon to say that the pavilion is eligible for the energy bill relief scheme.

7. Pavilion & Recreation Ground Matters

1. Replacement of rotten beam on climbing frame – work will commence on Monday 16th January.
2. Burst pipe and insurance claim – the sports club storage room. A burst pipe was reported on 19th December 22. A plumber attended to fix the issue but some of the equipment in the sports storage area was soaked. The kit was moved to the changing room to dry out. Two councillors inspected the damage and assessed that most of it was still usable after it had dried out. It was agreed that the club would receive a goodwill gesture payment of £30 so that they could replenish their first aid bag.
It was also noted that the gazebos in the same room were wet. These have now been moved to the store room and the covers spread out so that they dry off.
It was agreed that in future the water system should be drained down and anti-freeze added to the loos and sinks to avoid the likelihood of a similar incident.
